- **Teaching your Badge:**

- ⇒ Workbooks with instructions on how to teach the badge can be downloaded at <http://www.ctyankee.org/districts/powahay/webcollege> and found in the Webelos Handbook.
- ⇒ Keep it simple make it fun.
- ⇒ Consider a Team approach to teaching. This will allow to break up requirements between different instructors in a round-robin setting. It also allows for larger classes.
- ⇒ Classroom Setups. The earliest we can get into the school is 8 AM (we are under contract and paying for custodians). We won't know classroom assignments until we get there.
- ⇒ Please keep on schedule. If your class runs late then it effects the next group and those boys getting to the next class or to lunch. **The second session has to end at 11:50 to avoid lunch delays.**
- ⇒ If you are unable to complete your re-

quirements during the time period, please let us know so we can email that information out after the college.

- ⇒ We do have a budget and will reimburse for any supplies you need. Expenses over \$25 should be approved first
- ⇒ Please make sure boys **do not bring food or drinks into the classroom** and they are not playing around with any of the classroom items. If there is a mishap in your classroom, please let us know as we need to report it.

- **Advancement Procedures:**

- ⇒ Instructors do NOT sign off Cub Scout Books and/or requirements but we leave it to the Webelos Den Leader to feel confident that the requirements were taught properly.
- ⇒ We are not providing Awards and they must be purchased by the Pack and presented at a Pack Meeting.

- **Behavior Issues**

- ⇒ We hope to have walkie-talkies in each of our classrooms so that Staff can assist with behavior and/or emotional issues Instructors may have with a scout.
- ⇒ If a Scout is having problems, then please have an adult accompany him to the cafeteria.
- ⇒ Report any incidents no matter how small it may be.
- ⇒ We've had very minimal incidents over the years - this is not a big concern.
